Patent Grants from January to September 2025 Decrease by 508,000 YoY; Invention Patent Grants Down 16.6%, with a Grant Rate of Approximately 58.3% for the First Three Quarters

Recently, the China National Intellectual Property Administration (CNIPA) released its main intellectual property statistics for September 2025. A year-on-year (YoY) comparison with the same period in 2024 reveals the following:

For the period of January-September 2025,

invention patent grants decreased by 135,360 (-16.56% YoY),

while utility model grants fell by 391,442 (-25.92% YoY).

In contrast, design patent grants saw an increase of 17,842 (+3.86% YoY).

As of the end of September 2025, the total number of valid patents reached 20,941,187.

The grant rate for invention patents from January to September 2025 stood at 58.3%, a notable increase of two percentage points from the end of August. September's grant rate for invention patents reached 70.7%, making it the month with the highest number of grants this year.

(Note: The grant rate for invention patents is calculated as the number of grants divided by the number of concluded examinations).

Patents

Statistics by patentee type show that from January to September 2025, domestic invention patent grants decreased by 14.29% (YoY), with declines observed across all five patentee categories. Specially:

- Scientific Research Institutions: Patent grants decreased by 1.21% YoY.
- Universities & Colleges: Patent grants decreased by 2.54% YoY.
- Individuals: Invention patent grants saw a sharp decrease of 47.79% YoY.
- Enterprises: Invention patent grants decreased by 17.47% YoY.

For utility model patents, grants declined across all five patentee categories. Specifically:

- Grants to Individuals decreased by 54.28%.
- Grants to Universities & Colleges decreased by 43.38%.
- Grants to Scientific Research Institutions decreased by 34.28%.
- Grants to Enterprises decreased by 23.13%.

Trademarks

CNIPA Releases Trademark Statistics for January–September 2025

The China National Intellectual Property Administration (CNIPA) recently published trademark statistics for the period of January to September 2025.

Compared to the same period in 2024, trademark registrations from January to September 2025 decreased by 292,085, representing a year-on-year (YoY) decline of 8.14%.

During the same period, applications for review of rejection decreased by 19.69% YoY, and invalidation applications fell by 9.84% YoY.

In contrast, applications for review of cancellation increased by 1.95% YoY.



CNIPA Releases the "2024 Survey Report on Public Satisfaction with Intellectual Property Protection"

Recently, the China National Intellectual Property Administration (CNIPA) published the "2024 Survey Report on Public Satisfaction with Intellectual Property Protection" on its official website.

According to the report, CNIPA continued to conduct its in-depth survey on public satisfaction with IP protection in 2024. The survey was carried out using random sampling, collecting over 17,200 valid samples from 31 provinces (including autonomous regions and municipalities, but excluding Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan). The respondents comprised three main groups: IP rights holders, industry professionals, and the general public.

In 2024, the national satisfaction score for IP protection reached 82.36 (out of 100). This marks an increase of 0.32 points from 2023, 1.75 points since the beginning of the "14th Five-Year Plan" period (2021), 9.98 points since the start of the "13th Five-Year Plan" period (2016), and a significant 18.67 points since the survey's inception in 2012. Overall, the public satisfaction score for IP protection has demonstrated a consistent and steady upward trend in recent years.
